Full day private tour of Palermo and Monreale

Meet our local guide for a full day private guided tour. You will be enchanted by Palermo's wide boulevards, traditional Sicilian Old Quarter, and baroque palaces. You'll see the city's main sights, including Quattro Canti (the Four Corners), the Norman Castle and the twelfth century Cathedral, which houses a pantheon of royal tombs.

You will also visit the local open-air market where you will be able to enjoy some street-food tastings. Then, transfer with your guide to Monreale, just a few kilometers from Palermo. The old little town dating back to the 12th century stands in a privileged position that overlooks the so called "Conca d'Oro", which is the ancient perfumed valley of lemon trees. Here you will visit the magnificent Duomo, one of the most sumptuous example of the so-called Arab-Norman style, a "Unesco" World Heritage Site. Built by the Norman king William II, the Church became an important Bishop's site to balance the religious power of the nearby Palermo Cathedral. The magnificence of the golden mosaics, decorating the inside, will leave you simply astonished. The visit ends with a pleasant stroll into the elegant Benedictine monastery cloister of the XII century, enriched by inlaid columns and sculptured capitals.

Transfer back to Palermo for the rest of the day on your own. Duration: 8 hours

Private guided visit of Segesta



The archaeological site of Segesta is one of the most valuable historic sites in Sicily. The temple of Segesta, solemnly placed on a hill at the foot of Mount Barbaro, is certainly among the most exciting examples of Greek architecture. Completely isolated from the urban world, its white columns stand out among the green of the landscape; the greek theater is a further example of the importance that the city claimed in its past. Probably changed during the Roman period, the theater now has about 4,000 seats, divided over 20 orders of rows. Its construction dates back to the late fifth century BC, during the alliance with Athens.

Full Day Village Experience in Sant'Angelo Muxaro



Meet your English-speaking driver at your accommodation for your full day adventure in the area of Agrigento. You will meet locals and taste delicious flavors from ancient recipes that will always be impressed in your mind. Enjoy the true spirit of Sicily.



Visit Sant'Angelo Muxaro, a small village with a millennial history located about 30 km from Agrigento, in the hinterland, on a lonely hill in the middle of the Platani river valley. Sant'Angelo Muxaro is a great opportunity for Relational Tourism and you can already catch it in the eyes of who you meet along the little streets: people always ready to smile at you as they are grateful for the visit. Here you are not going to meet tourists or visitors of famous places but travelers in search of emotions. The millennial and fascinating history, the important archaeological heritage, the pristine and enveloping nature are only a backdrop for the real attraction of the place: the human relations and the great heart of the people. It is a walk among the picturesque village lanes with stops, tastings and encounters. A dairy stop with tasting of cheeses produced each day by a local family. A bakery stop with a taste of "pani cunzatu" (bread with local olive oil and pepper), almond cookies and honey, etc.

We will spend some time with some of these young shepherds who have given up everything to carry on the family trade of four generations.

Saturday

15 October 2022

Siracusa

Transfer to Siracusa with Stop in Piazza Armerina

The driver and guide will pick you up and transfer you to Piazza Armerina to visit the famous Roman Villa del Casale which contains some of the most amazing mosaics in the world. After that you will visit an olive oil mill and enjoy tasting and lunch before proceeding to Siracusa.

Hotel Antico Roma 1880, Siracusa 6 x Double superior (3 nights) - Breakfast daily included



There are very few hotels in Ortigia, and the Antico Hotel Roma 1880 is the most centrally located, actually next door to the cathedral, which is located in the old Doric Temple of Minerva. The hotel, founded in 1880, is framed on one side by the cathedral and on the other by the Archbishop's Palace and overlooks Piazza Minerva, which is a continuation of the Piazza Duomo that runs alongside the Doric columns of the Temple, and onto Siracusa's most central road, Via Roma. When the cathedral was the Temple of Minerva (known as Athena by the Greeks), as in all Greek temples the entrance was facing east. The stairway was therefore located inside the hotel, and some of its remains are still visible through glass panels in our floors. The outdoor tables and chairs placed in Piazza Minerva and the large indoor patio allow our guests to surround themselves in this ancient atmosphere, over breakfast, dinner or any other moment of relaxation. The interior has a strong Sicilian style, with the same limestone used for the Greek temples and Baroque palaces, traditional "secret" courtyards inherited from Arabian architecture, small hanging gardens, balconies in all the rooms and Dammus arches carved from volcanic rock in the restaurant

Sunday

16 October 2022

Siracusa

Half day tour of Syracuse with Archaeological park and Ortygia walking tour



Syracuse was the most important city in Sicily during the splendor of the Greek empire. And as you will see today, that sublime wealth has remained to this day; especially on the Ortigia Island. Here we can still see the limestone columns of a majestic Greek temple supporting what is nowadays the cathedral. You will start the tour with a visit to the Archaeological Park called Neapolis with his Greek amphitheater, which could also be flooded to make water games and water fights during the Roman Empire by storing water in swimming pools. After this cultural experience, enjoy a delightful stroll through the alleys of Ortygia Island, where the first Corinthian colonists landed, you will walk among the streets of Greek origin, the Medieval buildings and the Baroque churches where you will also visit the marvellous Duomo. Duration: 4 hours

Afternoon Boat Trip Plemmirio Nature Reserve



This exclusive boat trip starts from the port of Siracusa in Ortigia. You will reach the Plemmirio Nature reserve (south of Siracusa) by boat, stop there to take a swim and have lunch on board. Buffet lunch includes traditional Sicilian food and beverage. You will return to Ortigia around 5pm. Beach towels are provided on board.

Monday

17 October 2022

Siracusa

Full Day visit to Noto and Vendicari



Guiding you through myth and history, Roman antiquities and industrial archaeology, seaside and architecture, our tour will finally lead you to discover the archaeological and architectural treasures of the fertile coast of Noto already inhabited during the Bronze Age. The Vendicari Tower was built in order to defend the old dock in the first half of the fifteenth century. In addition, its position on the top of the promontory was suitable for tuna fishing. This aspect is currently shown not only by the near seventeenth-century tuna fishery owned by the Nicolacis of Villadorata, but also by the remains of an Hellenistic-Roman factory for fish processing. Our tour will continue inside the Roman Villa of the River Tellaro, whose excavations disclosed an important mosaic dating back to the middle of the fourth century AD. Duration: 8 hours

Taormina

Transfer to Taormina with stop and visit of Modica

Modica, whose county was the capital of one of the most important feudal states of Southern Italy, was born on the sides of two narrow valleys. Its twine of restricted alleys discloses wonderful Baroque buildings and churches, which are listed as UNESCO World Heritage sites. The territory of Modica rises in a geographical landscape whose beauty is more than rare. It is characterised by deep canyons that influence the calcareous Hyblaen plateau. Therefore Modica will strike your imagination by virtue of its different landscapes, monuments and traditional delicacies. All these elements are the result of a long and historical process that began in prehistory. Duration: 4 hours

Considered one of Italy's most historic holiday resorts and the Pearl of the Ionian Sea, Taormina is a picturesque small town perched on a slope high above the Ionian Sea on the eastern coast of Sicily. Dating back as far as 358 BC, it's home to some of the most well-preserved buildings, medieval courtyards and historic landmarks. A popular and fashionable destination for well over a century. Close to the site of one of the earliest colonies founded by the Ancient Greeks in Sicily, Taormina became a thriving Greek and then Roman town. The size and elegance of the town cathedral and many of its buildings are evidence of Taormina's moderate prosperity over the centuries. By the end of the 19th century this picturesque and ancient town was already on the tourist trail, with famous visitors including Oscar Wilde, Richard Wagner and Tsar Nicholas II. The town's star attraction is with no doubts the Ancient Greek Roman Theatre with its wonderful location suspended between the sky and the ionian sea with a magnificent view on the mighty Etna smoking in the distance.

Catania is the second largest city in Sicily and is located approximately 30 kilometers from the volcano, Etna. Throughout history, this elegant and charming city was dominated by Romans, Byzantines, Arabs and Normans. This resulted in a rich cultural mix. In 1669, Etna changed this flourishing city. During the worst volcanic eruption of this giant, the entire city was destroyed. The residents did not give up and managed to rebuild and restore large parts of the city. However, in 1693 the tragedy hit again. This time an earthquake destroyed entire neighborhoods. After World War II, the city experienced another revival. Today, the 17th century Baroque buildings color the elegant historic center of black and white. Amongst the best highlights of the City: The picturesque "Piscaria" citizen fishmarket in the very heart of the City; the largest Roman amphitheater in Sicily that could hold about 15,000 spectators seated; The Beautiful Cathedral, so important to many Catanesi (Catania inhabitants) containing the extremely precious and sacred relics of the Patron Saint Agatha Martyr; The beautiful Public Garden, a place to spend a little time relaxing and enjoying a quiet rest during your sightseeing full of plants, trees, fountains and a great place for people-watching Duration: 3 hours

Non-U.S. citizens should contact the embassy or consulate of their destination countries to enquire about visa requirements.

Clients are reminded to ensure that the name on their passport is an exact match with the name on their airline ticket. Airlines cannot accept tickets issued with names incorrectly spelled under any circumstances (even if by one letter only or if a shortened version of a name is used e.g. Tim instead of Timothy) and passengers will be denied boarding. If name on ticket is spelled incorrectly, a new ticket will need to be purchased and applicable refund charges will apply. See Italy travel is not liable and will not be responsible to Client if Client provides inaccurate or incomplete passenger data.

No travel is without risk. While we will advise you of known travel risks and travel advisories that are in effect for your destination, you should take steps and are responsible to be aware of any travel advisories or travel warnings that are in effect at the time of travel and prepare accordingly. The ultimate decision on where to travel is up to you. Payment Terms

To confirm and book an itinerary, Client must submit (1) a fully completed Reservation Form, (2) full payment of travel insurance and (3) a non-refundable 30% deposit of your itinerary price to See Italy Travel. Please note that no portion of the 30% deposit is refundable. Certain operators/ suppliers may require additional non-refundable deposits upon confirmation of your itinerary, of which you will be advised. In addition, there may be fees or allowances for baggage. Upon receipt of your Reservation Form and deposit, See Italy Travel will make best efforts to attempt to secure and contract the requested itinerary on behalf of its Client.

A 30% nonrefundable deposit to See Italy will be required to secure your reservations at the time of booking. The remaining balance of the Travel Package and Services will then be due 60 days prior to departure. If booking within 60 days of departure, full payment is due at time of booking. If we do not receive any payment due in full and on time, we reserve the right to treat your booking as cancelled by you in which case the cancellation charges set out below will become payable. We reserve the right to refuse a booking without giving any reason and shall in that event return any deposit received.

Once a booking has been confirmed to us, we will change the booking's status from "provisional" to "confirmed" on condition that we have a 30% non-refundable deposit from you AND a completed and signed copy of the Reservation Form and Terms and Conditions.

Airfare quotes are estimates only and are subject to change until the ticket is issued. Certain operators/suppliers quote rates in foreign currencies and as these rates fluctuate relative to the US Dollar, all quotes prices are estimates only. The final invoice will reflect a tour price based on the then current exchange rate. The balance of payment is due no later than 60 (sixty) days prior to commencement of your travel arrangements. If the reservation is made within 60 days of arrival, full payment will be required in order to secure reservations.

Cancellations & Changes by the Client

61+ days prior to departure = Full penalty on the nonrefundable deposit.

60 days prior to departure = 100% of the See Italy Travel Package and Services is nonrefundable.

"Days Prior to Departure" calculation is based on the date of receipt of a written notice. The cancellation notice can be sent via email to info@seeitalytravel.com, fax (858-597-0757), or standard mail. If the cancellation notice is sent via standard mail, please request a "return receipt of delivery" from the postal service, as See Italy is not responsible for any lost mailed cancellation notices.

Cancellations by phone still require a written notification from the client. There are no exceptions to our cancellation policy. It is for this reason See Italy recommends cancel-for-any-reason trip insurance at the time of deposit. No refunds are made for unused meals, services, or lodging. Changes made after deposit may incur additional fees to be determined at the time of the change. **If the Client initiates a improper credit card chargeback, such as to avoid cancellation penalties, the Client consents to jurisdiction of a California court, agrees to waive the right to a jury trial, and shall be responsible for all costs of collection, including attorneys' fees and cost.**

Cancellation by See Italy

If it becomes necessary or advisable for any reason whatsoever to alter the itinerary or arrangements, such alterations shall be made. Should a traveler be removed from a trip, they will not be refunded any unused portions of the Vacation Package and Services provided by See Italy.
